







# Premature Births, 2012 and 2014

- 63% of providers that responded to the stakeholder survey rated access to prenatal/maternal care as 'Hard' or 'Very Hard' for the low-income community in RHP 7.



Shown as Percent of Total Births




# STI Rates per 100,000, 2012 and 2015


