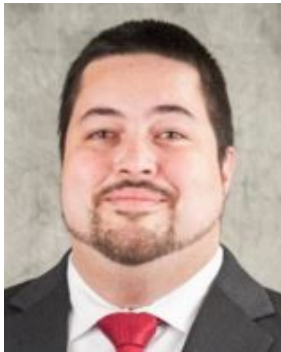
#### Health Care for the Homeless



**Dr. Audrey Kuang, Internal Medicine, CommUnityCare Health Centers**

She has worked with vulnerable populations, specifically those experiencing homelessness for over 15 years. She believes in the importance of addressing social and environmental factors on both an individual and community levels to improve and sustain health.
