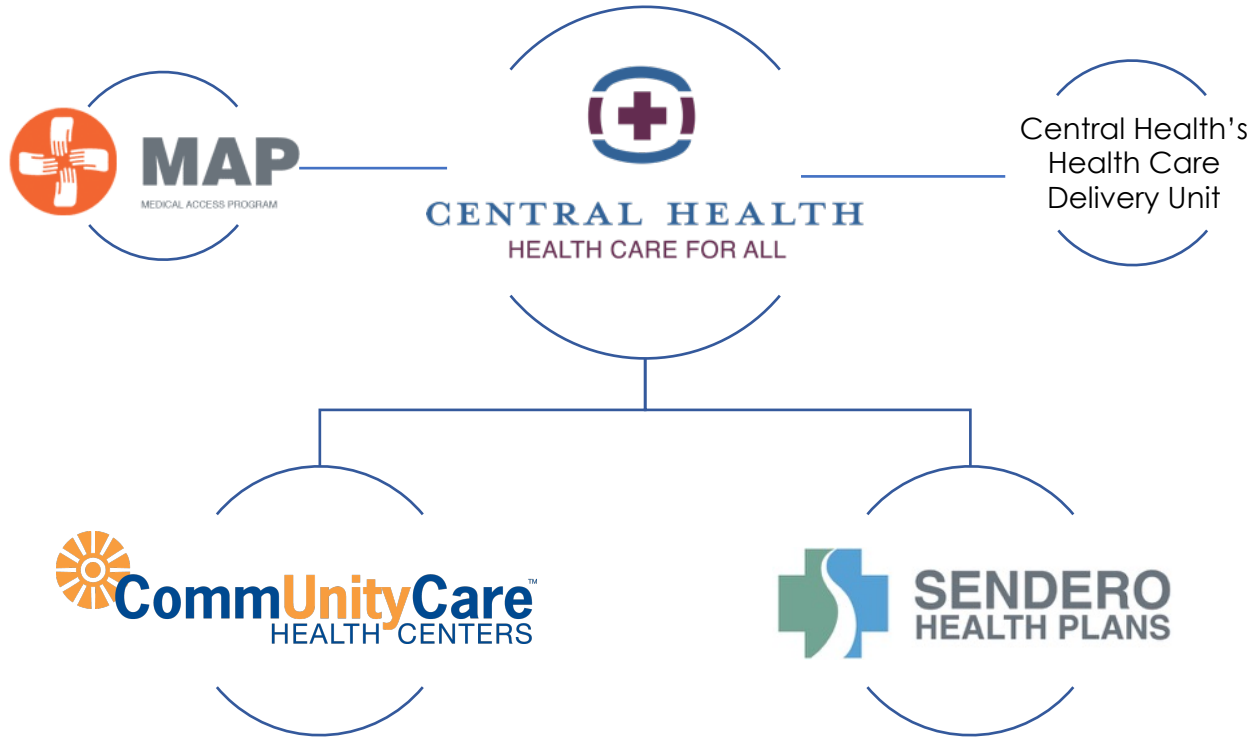

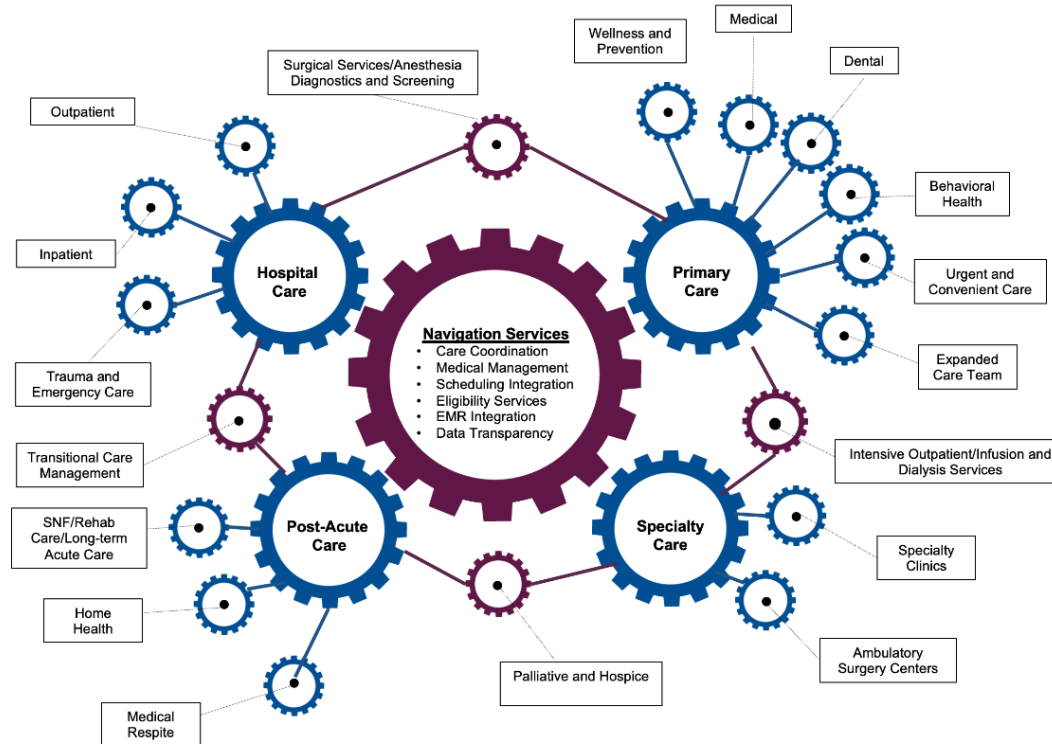

Access to Quality Services

- Partnering with providers committed to serving our population
- Providing access to a variety of services
- Ensuring high quality services

Example: Diabetes Care

Requires access to variety of services

- Endocrinologist
- Podiatry
- Retina Specialist
- Nephrologist
- Dialysis



High Quality

Increase number of patients:

- With diabetes who receive 3-point foot exam
- With diabetes who receive annual retina screening
- With diabetes who have their HbA1c under control
- Whose BMI is within safe limits

Decrease number of patients:

- With diabetes who have lower limb amputations
