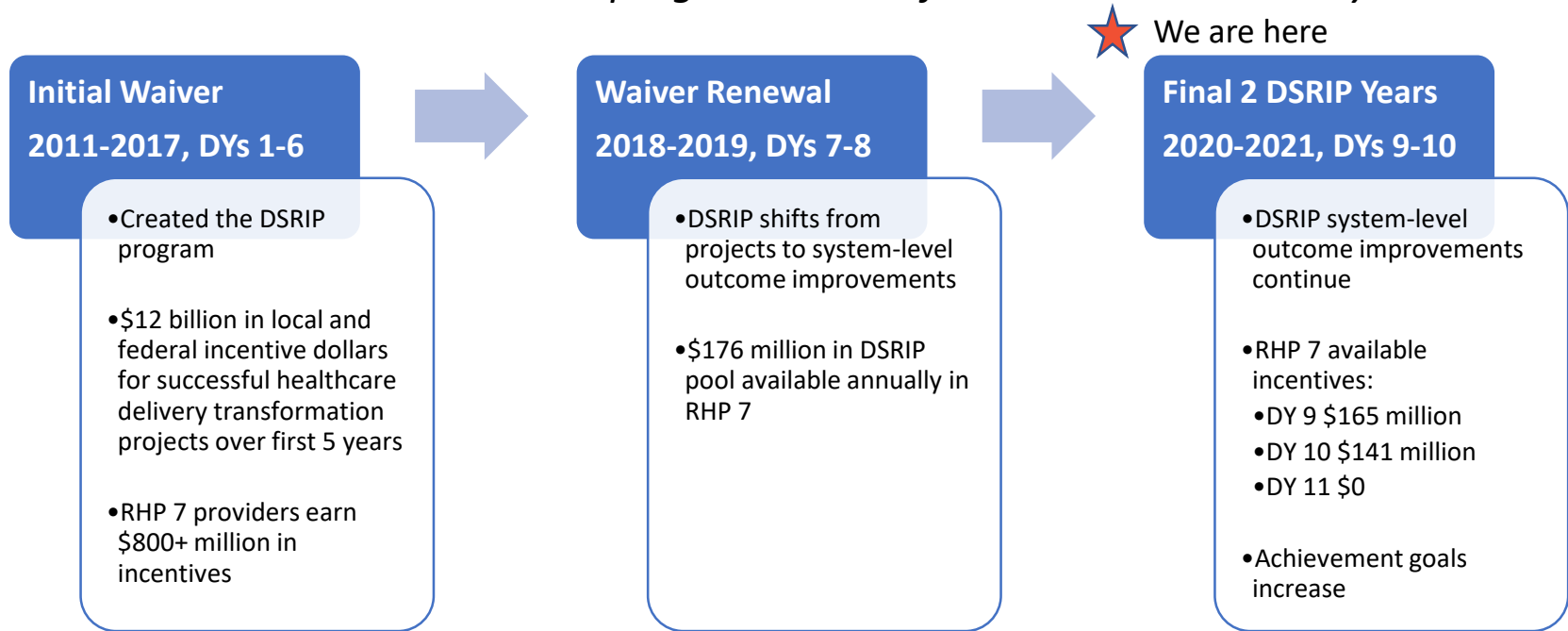

1115 Medicaid Waiver – DSRIP Program

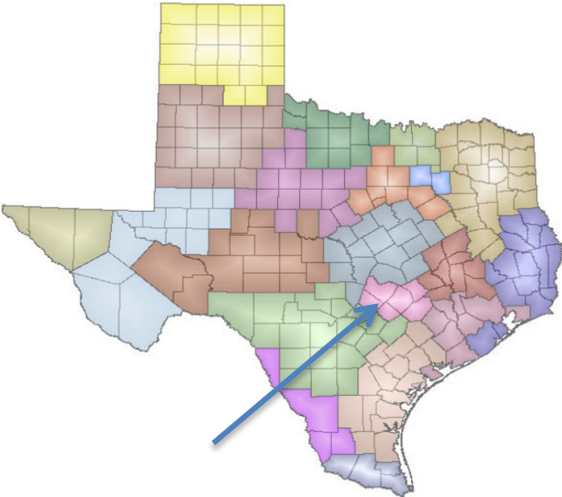
Time-limited incentive program to transform healthcare delivery

Major Themes of RHP 7 Plan Update - DY 9-10

- **Screening and Prevention**
 - Immunizations, cancer, chronic disease
- **Chronic Care Management**
 - Diabetes, cancer, heart disease
- **Maternal and Infant Health**
 - Reduce leading causes of preventable death/complications
- **Physical and Behavioral Health Integration**
 - Integrating care strategies to treat the whole person
- **Behavioral Health**
 - Crisis stabilization, substance abuse, community based care
- **Access to care**
 - Specialty care, dental, rural access, telehealth

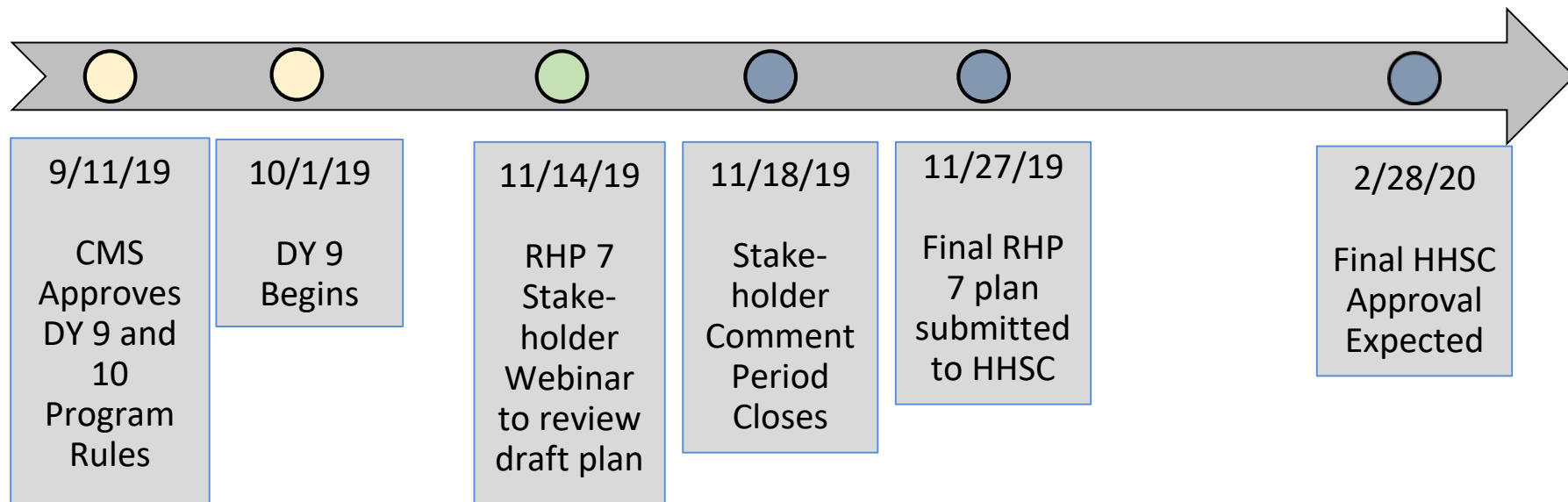

Community Care Collaborative	22,958	100%
Dell Children's Medical Center	60,657	58%
Dell Seton Medical Center at UT	60,742	70%
Integral Care	24,153	83%
St. David's South Austin Medical Center	135,458	44%

"System Population" = Provider's Patient Population (PPP); "MLIU" = Medicaid and Low Income Uninsured
