RECITALS

On September 16, 2025, the Commissioners Court adopted an Order of the Travis County Commissioners Court Relating to the Travis County Healthcare District D/B/A Central Health Making Tax Levies for the Tax Year Beginning January 1, 2025.

By order made and entered into the minutes of this Commissioners Court, the adoption of the tax rate for the Travis County Healthcare District was approved.

From the information provided to the Commissioners Court before that meeting, and from the certified minutes of the Court, it is clear that the Commissioners Court intended to and did adopt a total tax rate of \$0.118023. The certified minutes of the Commissioners Court confirm that the tax rate motions read and approved in Commissioners Court on September 16, 2025 were correct, and reflected the total tax rate of \$0.118023 approved by Commissioners Court.

However, the copy of the Order signed by the members of the Commissioners Court contained two typographical errors, on page 4. The digits "8" and "0" were transposed, resulting in the Order reflecting a total tax rate of \$0.110823 and a percentage increase of 6.0 percent, rather than the correct figures. The signed Order did not reflect the discussion, motion, and vote of the Commissioners Court approving the correct total tax rate of \$0.118023, which represents an 8.0 percent increase in the tax rate. It is therefore necessary to correct these clerical errors so that the Order conforms to the certified minutes and the actions taken by the Commissioners Court on September 16, 2025.

After due consideration of the original Order signed by the Commissioners Court on September 16, 2025, the Commissioners Court finds that the Order entered in its minutes contains two clerical errors relating to the total tax rate calculation for the tax year beginning January 1, 2025.

ORDER

Therefore, the Commissioners Court orders that:


1. The attached Nunc Pro Tunc Order is approved,







\$0.113569 Total Maintenance and Operations Tax

DEBT SERVICE:

\$0.004454 Total Debt Service Tax

TOTAL TAX RATE:

\$0.118023 Total Tax Rate

The two components of the Travis County Healthcare District d/b/a Central Health tax rate for the current year having been approved in this resolution, property taxes are increased by the adoption of a tax rate of \$0.113569 for maintenance and operations; the adoption of a tax rate of \$0.004454 for total debt service; and there is hereby levied for the current tax year a total Travis County Healthcare District d/b/a Central Health *ad valorem* tax of \$0.118023 for each \$100 valuation of all taxable property.


THIS TAX RATE WILL RAISE MORE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS THAN LAST YEAR'S TAX RATE.


THE TAX RATE WILL EFFECTIVELY BE RAISED BY 8.0 PERCENT AND WILL RAISE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS ON A \$100,000 HOME BY APPROXIMATELY \$8.41 (EIGHT DOLLARS AND FORTY-ONE CENTS).



A. Total Maintenance and Operations Tax Rate

MOTION: For the total maintenance and operations tax rate, I move that the Central Health property tax rate be increased by the adoption of a tax rate of \$0.113569, which is effectively an eight percent (8.0%) increase in the tax rate.

B. Total Debt Service Tax Rate

MOTION: For the debt service tax rate, I move that the Central Health property tax be decreased by the adoption of a tax rate of \$0.004454, which is effectively a three-tenths percent (0.3%) decrease in the tax rate.

C. Total Ad Valorem Tax Rate (Judge Brown)

MOTION: For the total ad valorem tax rate, which is the sum of the maintenance and operations tax rate and debt service tax rate, I move that the Central Health property tax rate be increased by the adoption of a tax rate of \$0.118023, which is effectively a nine and three tenths percent (9.3%) increase in the tax rate.

RESULT: **APPROVED - UNANIMOUS**

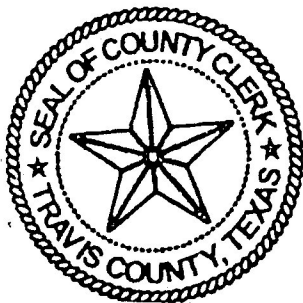
